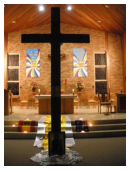




St Paul's Youth Scene

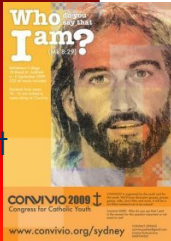

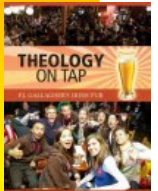

Preparing For Madrid WYD

This is the Logo for Madrid WYD.....

The image reflects the youth of the world beneath the cross, united to form the crown of Our Lady of La Almudena, the patroness of Madrid. The Crown also form's the 'M' for Mary and Madrid. The Cross the symbol of Christianity presides over the event. The two circles in the 'peaks' of the 'M' represent the heads of two youngsters united to celebrate the faith. These two youngsters represent all the youth of the world.

The warm colours of red, orange and yellow – transmits the unmistakable warmth and friendliness, symbols of the identity of Madrid.... These colours also reflect the divine warmth of Trinitarian Love.
